U.S. Environmental Protection Agency

Eligibility

Applications must meet **all** eligibility criteria, as outlined in [Section III](#) of the NOFO, to be considered for funding.



Comply with the content and submission requirements.



Meet the statutory partnership requirements in [Section III.A](#).



Projects must benefit disadvantaged communities (see [Section III.D](#).)



Projects must be completed within three years.



Applications to conduct scientific research; assessment, removal, or remediation of Superfund sites; or community relocation are ineligible.

Track I

Community-Driven Investments for Change

Funding Available: approx. \$1.96 billion

Number of Awards: approx. 150

Per Award Amount: \$10M - \$20M each

Track II

Meaningful Engagement for Equitable Governance

Funding Available: approx. \$40 million

Number of Awards: approx. 20

Per Award Amount: \$1M - \$3M each

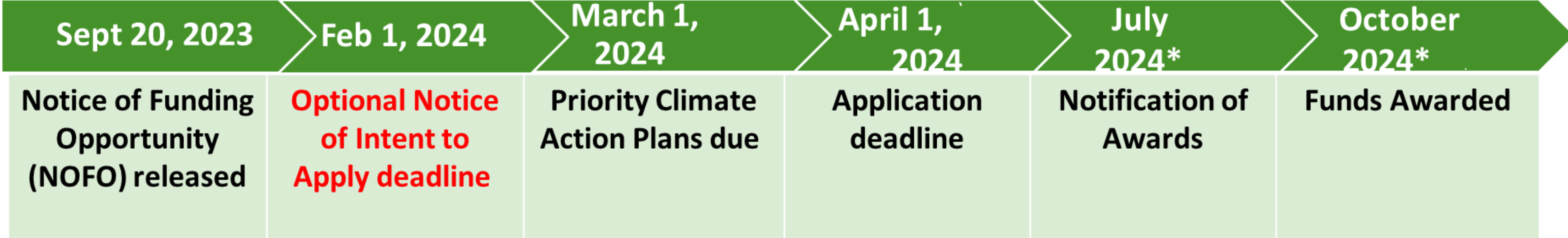
CPRG Overview and Timeline

CPRG Planning Grants

- \$250 million awarded in 2023
- Priority Climate Action Plans due March 1—establish eligible projects for implementation funds
- Housing authorities can coordinate with lead planning grant agencies on plan development

CPRG Implementation Grants

- \$4.6 billion to fund GHG reduction projects
- Public housing authorities may be eligible to apply if they document that they constitute a public body created by or pursuant to State law and are accountable to municipal or state units of government.
- Must apply for projects included in a Priority Climate Action Plan (see above)

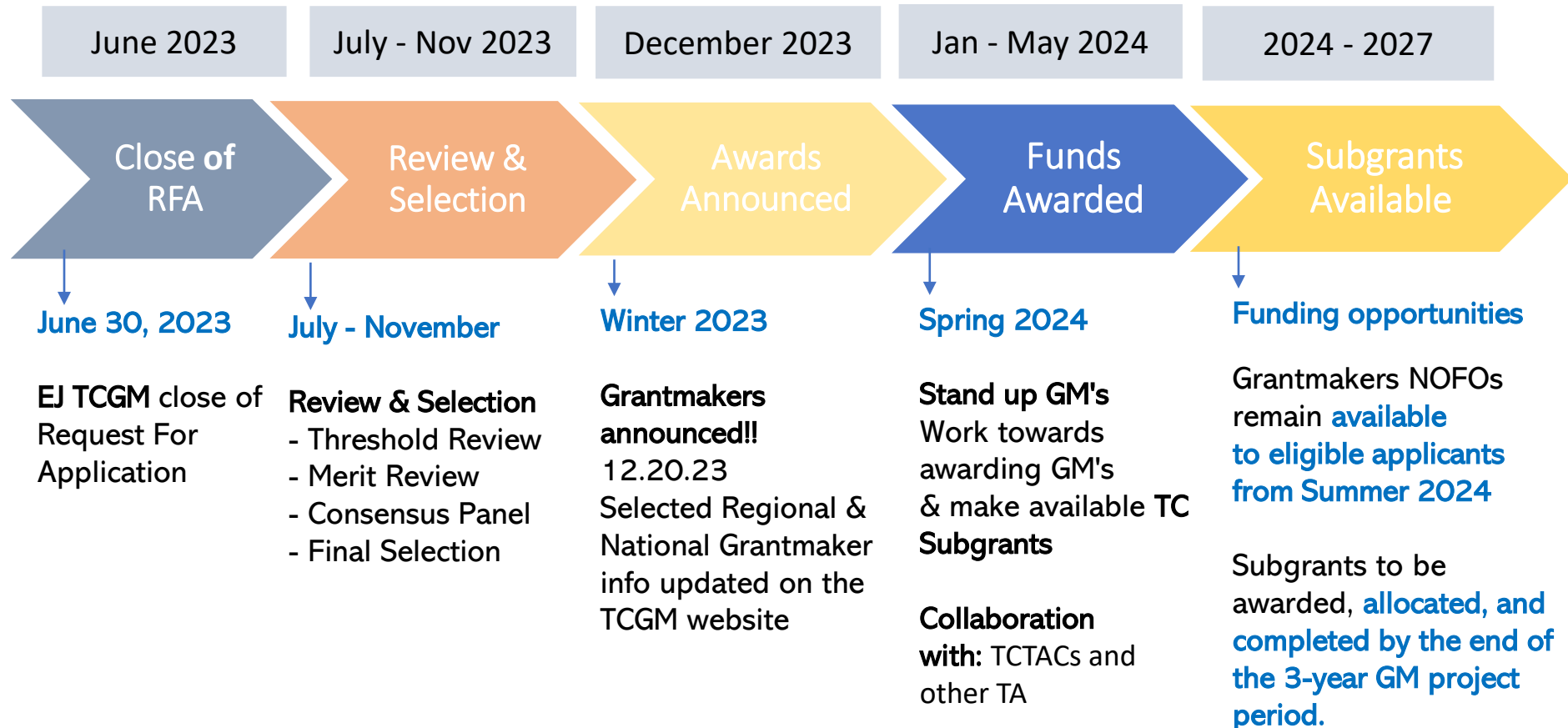
