
Housing and Education (HousED)



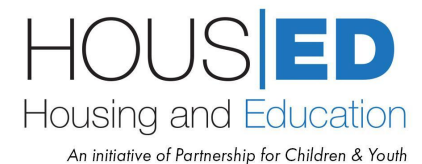


