HARDEST HIT HOUSING ACT OF 2018

Fighting to ensure people have access to affordable housing.

PUBLIC HOUSING GRANTS

Supplies the Public Housing Capital Fund Grant Program with \$4 billion dollars in funds per year over five years for public housing authorities that own or manage more than 10,000 units.



FORECLOSURE MITIGATION & ASSISTANCE GRANTS



Provides \$5 million per year for five years for foreclosure prevention and mitigation to 15 metropolitan areas with the greatest need as of January 1, 2018.

RENTAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS

Authorizes the funding of 100,000 incremental housing vouchers for housing authorities that administer over 10,000 vouchers at a rate of 20,000 over five years.

FOR RENT

Home prices and rents are hitting all-time highs, pricing lowincome and middle-class families out of the market. Donald Trump's 2019 budget proposal includes the same draconian and unpopular cuts that failed in Congress last year. The federal government should be doing more, to relieve the

housing crisis, not less in America. The Hardest Hit Housing Act is a great first step in that process.
